IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION TO MINIMIZE THE RISK OF IMMUNE- MEDIATED ADVERSE REACTIONS

This medicine may cause serious side effects, which can sometimes become life-threatening and lead to death. These may happen any time during treatment or even after your treatment has ended. You may experience more than one side effect at the same time.

Contact your doctor right away if you develop any signs or symptoms, including those not listed on this card. Your doctor may give you other medicines in order to prevent more severe complications and reduce your symptoms. Your doctor may withhold the next dose of ZYNYZ® or stop treatment.

TALK TO YOUR DOCTOR IF YOU HAVE ANY OF THESE SYMPTOMS/SIDE EFFECTS:

Lungs

- Breathing difficulties
- Chest pain
- New or worsening cough

Intestines

- Frequent diarrhea often with blood and/or mucus
- More bowel movements than usual
- Stools that are bloody, black or tarry
- Severe abdominal pain or tenderness

Liver

- Persistent nausea or vomiting
- Loss of appetite
- Pain on the right side of your stomach
- Eye and/or skin yellowing
- Drowsiness
- Dark-coloured urine
- Bleeding or bruising more easily than normal

Kidneys

- Decreased volume of urine
- Foamy urine
- Passing blood or traces of blood in the urine that may change its colour
- Swollen ankles
- Loss of appetite

Hormone glands

- Thyroid gland problems
- Headache
- Nausea
- Vomiting
- Increased thirst
- Vision changes

Type 1 diabetes or diabetic ketoacidosis

- Difficulty thinking clearly
- Sleepiness
- Stomach pain
- Fast and deep breathing
- Breath that smells sweet or fruity
- Sweet or metallic taste in the mouth
- Different odor to urine or sweat

Skin

- Chills
- Shaking or fever
- Itching or rash
- Flushing or swollen face
- Being short of breath or wheezing
- Feeling dizzy or feel like passing out and back or neck pain
- Nausea
- Vomiting
- Abdominal pain

Other organs

- Inflammation of the pancreas, eyes, joints, tissue between the muscle and skin which may cause swelling
- Muscle and bone pain
- Pinched nerve

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR HEALTHCARE PROVIDERS

This patient is being treated with ZYNYZ® (retifanlimab), which can cause immune-mediated adverse reactions that may appear any time during treatment or even after treatment. Assess patients for signs and symptoms of immune-mediated adverse reactions. Early diagnosis and appropriate management are essential to minimize any consequences of immune-mediated adverse reactions.

Specific guidelines for managing immune-mediated adverse reactions are available in the Product Monograph for retifanlimab.

Consultation with an oncologist or other medical specialist may be helpful for management of organ specific immune-mediated adverse reactions.
